- Administration

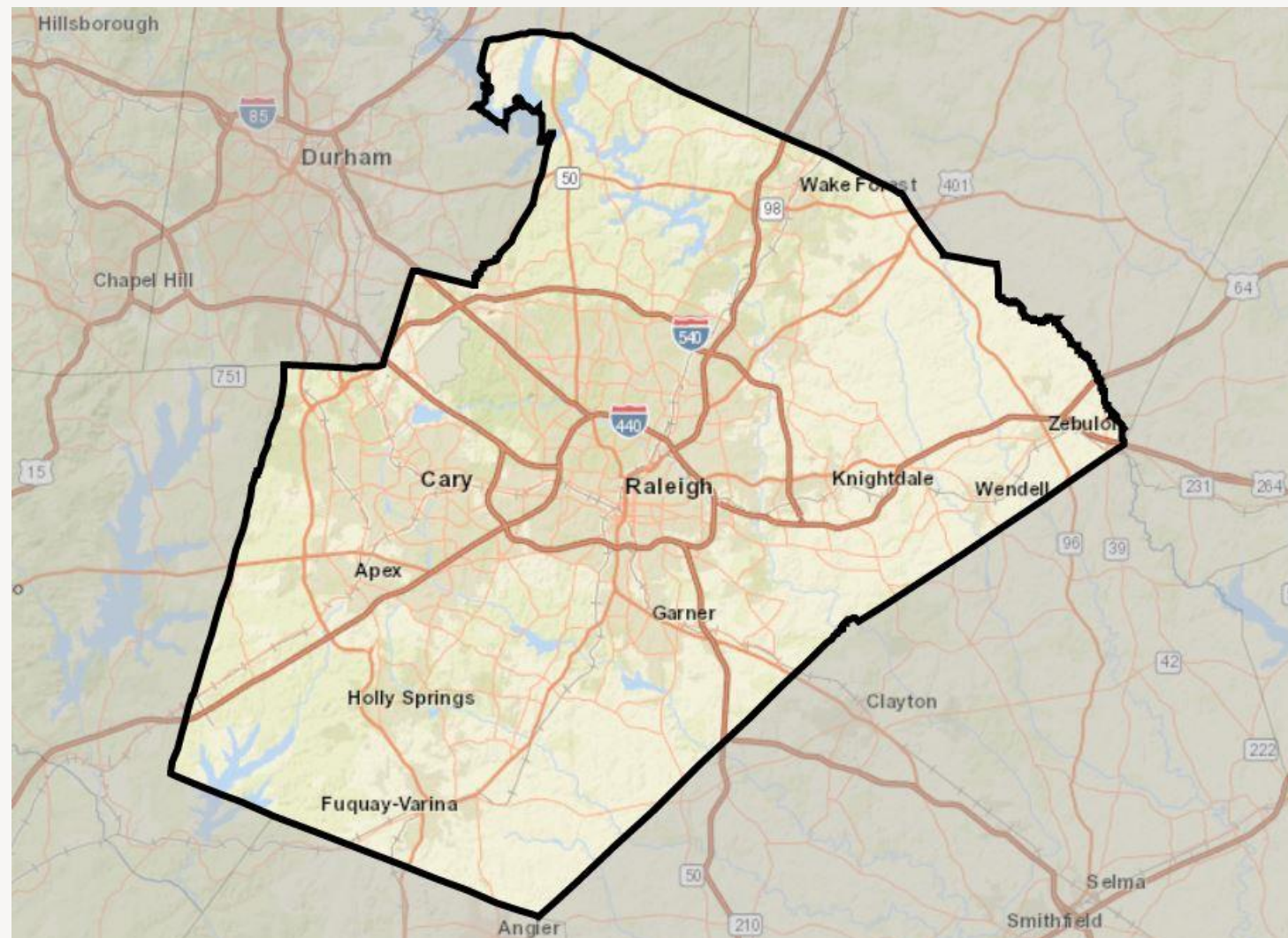

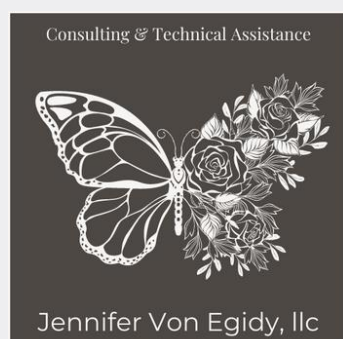

PPRN	Estimated ARD	Tier 1	CoC Bonus	DV Bonus	CoC Planning
PRELIMINARY PRO RATA NEED: The total amount of funds a CoC could receive based on a HUD formula.	ANNUAL RENEWAL DEMAND: The total amount of all the CoC's projects that will be eligible for renewal.	TIER 1: Equal to 93% of ARD. Projects ranked within Tier 1 are conditionally awarded.	CoC BONUS: Collaborative application must demonstrate CoC ranks projects based on how they improve system performance. Incentives using housing vouchers and healthcare through an array of healthcare services providers.	DV BONUS: A new project serving survivors of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, stalking, etc. (can be used in expansion projects too!)	CoC PLANNING: An application is submitted, but not ranked. It is automatically awarded upon eligibility of consolidated application.

What's important in
the 2023 NOFO?

HUD Homeless Policy Priorities

- End homelessness for all persons.
- Use a Housing First approach.
- Reduce unsheltered homelessness.
- Improve system performance.
- Partner with housing, health, and service agencies.
- Promote racial equity and address racial disparities.
- Improve assistance to LGBTQ+ individuals.
- Engage persons with lived experience of homelessness.
- Engage in efforts to increase affordable housing supply.



Key Changes for FY2023



Homeless Definition was amended to:

- Is **experiencing trauma or a lack of safety related to, or fleeing or attempting to flee, domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, stalking or other dangerous, traumatic, or life-threatening conditions related to the violence against the individual or a family member in the individual's or family's current housing situation, including where the health and safety of children are jeopardized;**
- Has no other safe residence; and
- Lacks the resources to obtain other safe permanent housing.



Key Changes for FY2023



- CoC Planning increase from 3% to 5% of FPRN
- New Eligible Activity: VAWA
 - facilitating and coordinating activities to ensure compliance with emergency transfer plan requirements and monitoring compliance with confidentiality protections

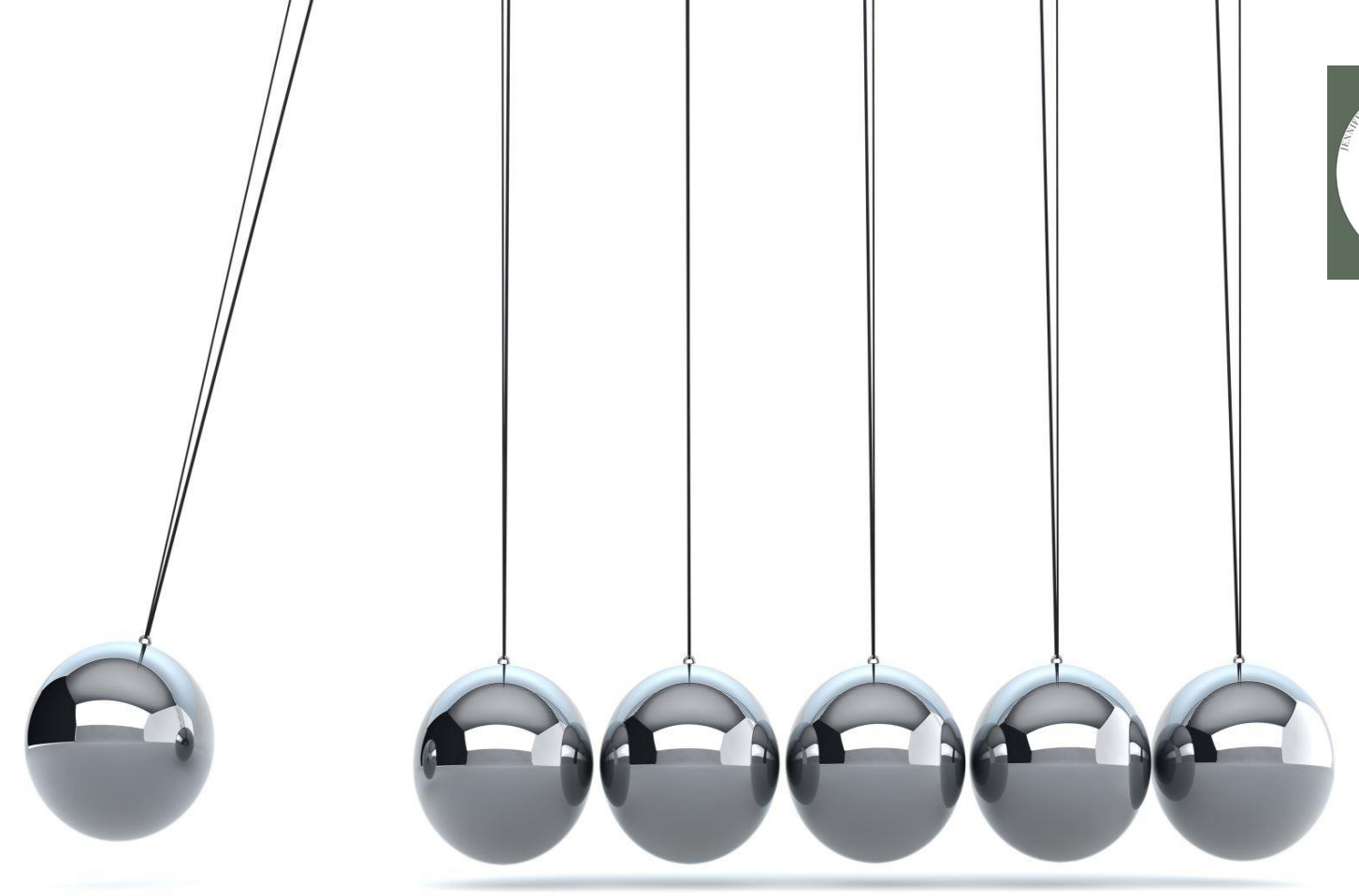
Key dates and deadlines

Activity	DATE
2023 CoC Program NOFO release	WEDNESDAY, JULY 5, 2023
All project applications are required to be submitted to the CoC. CoCs that fail to establish this deadline for local project application(s) will lose points.	30 days prior to submission deadline
The CoC is required to notify all project applicants who submitted their project applications to the CoC by the CoC-established deadline whether their project application(s) will be accepted and ranked on the CoC Priority Listing, rejected, or reduced by the CoC.	15 days prior to submission deadline
CoCs must post on their website (or a partner's website) all parts of the CoC Consolidated Application and notify community members and key stakeholders that the Consolidated Application is available.	On or before Tuesday, September 26, 2023 (2 days prior to submission deadline):
SUBMISSION DEADLINE	THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 28, 2023 AT 8:00 PM EDT

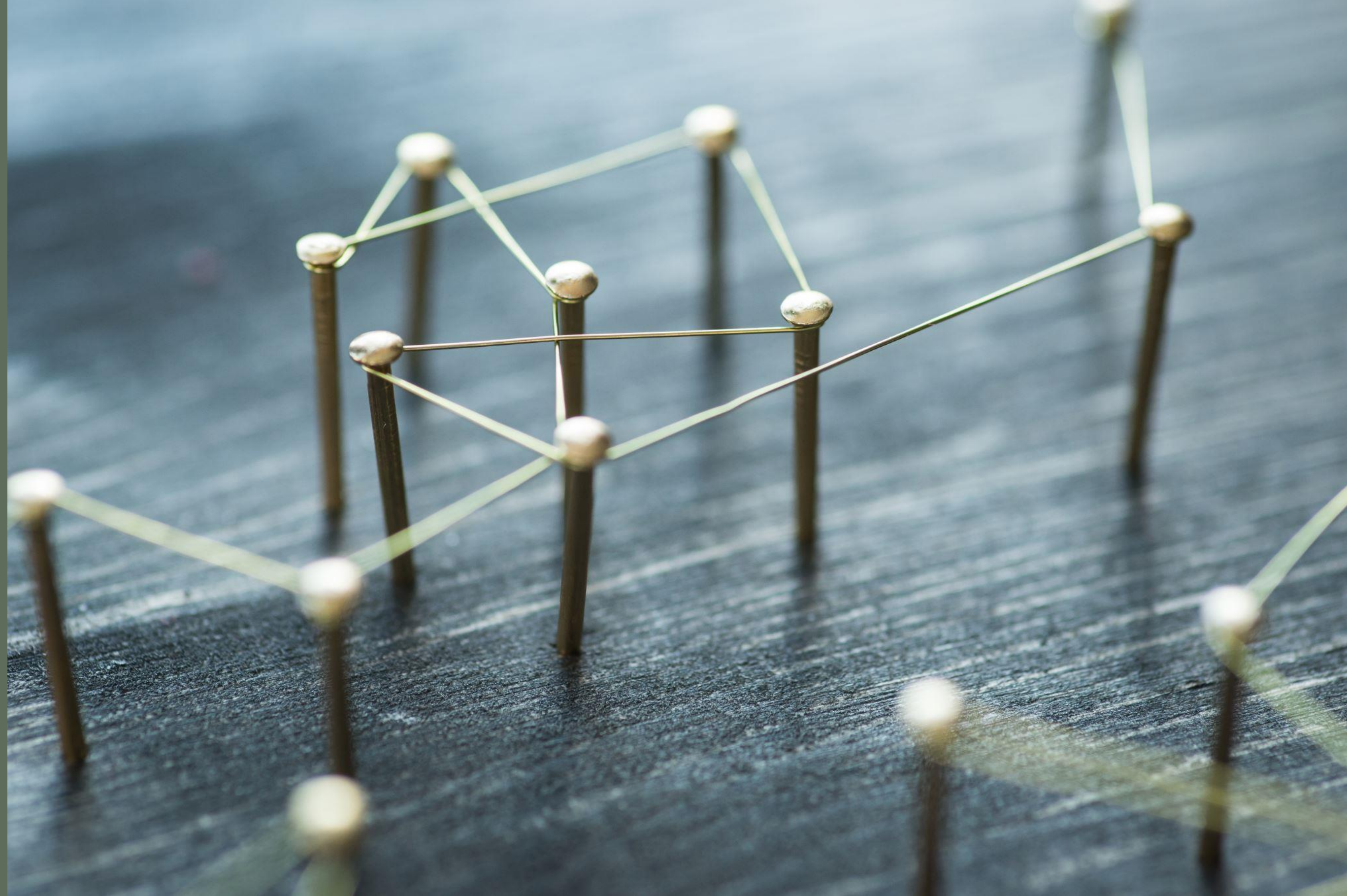

Funding Review Committee Interviews	Sept 12 - 13
CoC Boards meets to approve Funding Review Committee Recommendations	Wednesday September 13, 2023
Project Applications will be notified of Boards decisions, Appeals process begins	Wednesday September 13, 2023
Appeals Due	Noon, Tuesday September 19, 2023
Funding Review Committee meets to review appeals	Wednesday September 20, 2023
CoC Boards meets to review Appeals and Finalize Applicants	Thursday, September 21, 2023
