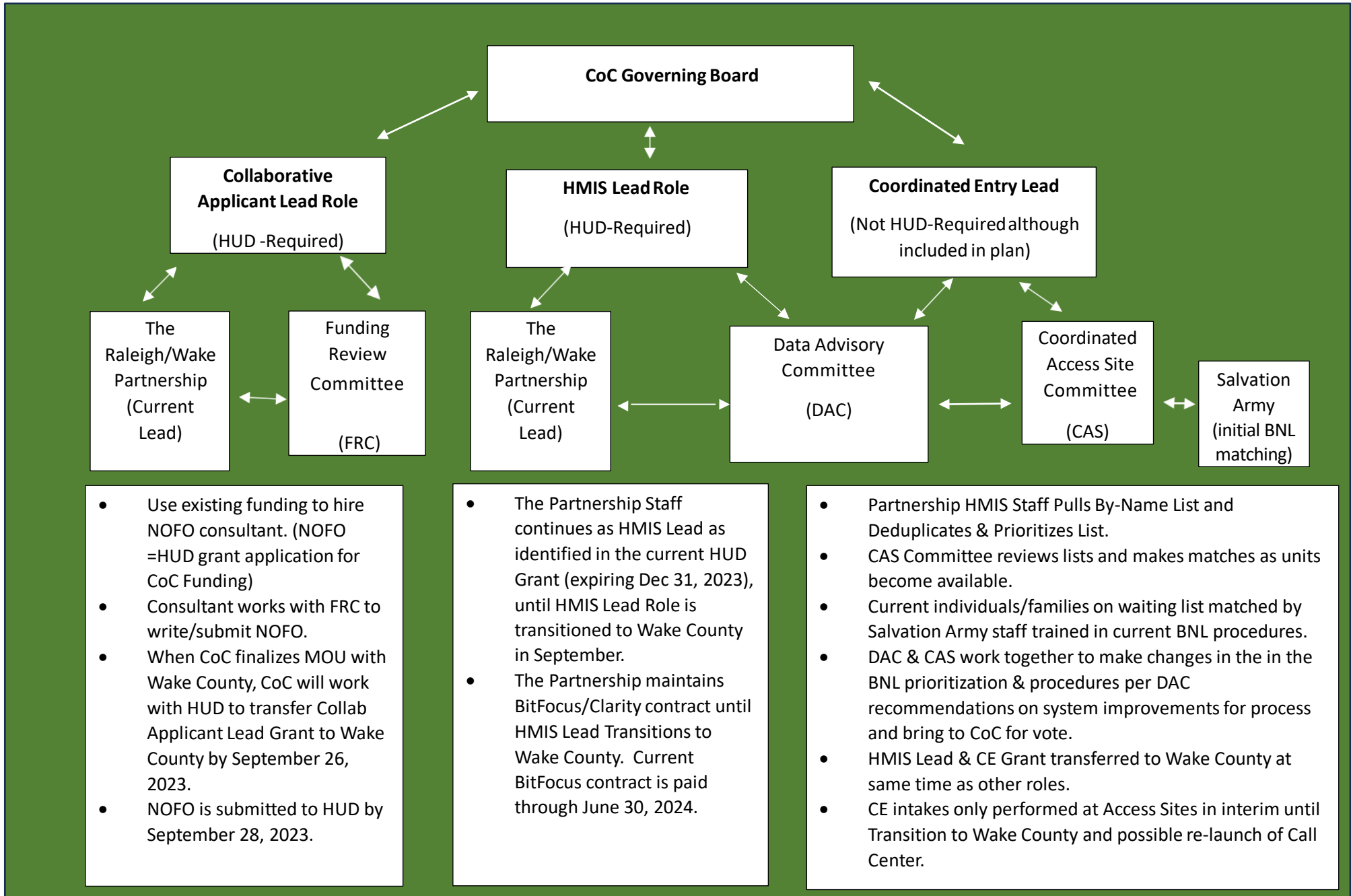




# NC 507 CoC Lead Interim Transition Plan- August 2, 2023

(Transition of Lead Roles to Wake County contingent on a mutually agreed upon, HUD-Approved MOU)



- Use existing funding to hire NOFO consultant. (NOFO =HUD grant application for CoC Funding)
- Consultant works with FRC to write/submit NOFO.
- When CoC finalizes MOU with Wake County, CoC will work with HUD to transfer Collab Applicant Lead Grant to Wake County by September 26, 2023.
- NOFO is submitted to HUD by September 28, 2023.

- The Partnership Staff continues as HMIS Lead as identified in the current HUD Grant (expiring Dec 31, 2023), until HMIS Lead Role is transitioned to Wake County in September.
- The Partnership maintains BitFocus/Clarity contract until HMIS Lead Transitions to Wake County. Current BitFocus contract is paid through June 30, 2024.

- Partnership HMIS Staff Pulls By-Name List and Deduplicates & Prioritizes List.
- CAS Committee reviews lists and makes matches as units become available.
- Current individuals/families on waiting list matched by Salvation Army staff trained in current BNL procedures.
- DAC & CAS work together to make changes in the in the BNL prioritization & procedures per DAC recommendations on system improvements for process and bring to CoC for vote.
- HMIS Lead & CE Grant transferred to Wake County at same time as other roles.
- CE intakes only performed at Access Sites in interim until Transition to Wake County and possible re-launch of Call Center.
