

## FY 2024 Wake CoC Local HUD NOFO Competition Information

The NC 507 Wake County Continuum of Care (CoC) is charged by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to submit a community-wide application for homeless assistance funds.

FY 2024 HUD CoC Program Competition Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) is published and can be accessed above and at [CoC Program Competition page](#).

HUD has not certified the exact funding available for the FY2024 Competition at this time.

The NC 507 Wake County Continuum of Care's estimated Annual Renewal Demand (ARD) is: \$4,385,167. Additional bonus funding is also available: Domestic Violence (DV) Bonus up to 15% of the Wake CoC's Preliminary Pro-Rata Need (PPRN) and CoC Bonus up to 12% of the Wake CoC's Final Pro-Rata Need (FPRN) is also available to create one or more new project applications. New projects created through the CoC Bonus must meet the project eligibility and project quality threshold requirements established by HUD in sections III.C.4.a. and b. of this NOFO. For the annual Planning grant, 5% of the CoC's FPRN or \$50,000, whichever is greater, is available to the Wake CoC. The Department of Housing and Development (HUD) has not certified the exact funding available for the FY 2024 CoC Competition at this time. Successful applicants will demonstrate clear strategies that address inequities for underserved

persons and marginalized communities for housing and/or support services in Wake County.
