

2026 Wake CoC Governing Board Slate

Updated: November 10, 2025

Overview

Per the CoC Charter, the Nominations Committee conducted the 2026 Wake CoC Governing Board selection process.

The Governing Board shall consist of at least 15, but no more than 23 members. There are 10 seats, three (3) that are currently vacant and seven (7) with a term expiring in December 2025. This includes one new Governing Board seat for "Community Member" as approved by the CoC Membership through the 2025 CoC Charter ¹Review process.

The application form for CoC Board candidates was open September 23 through October 24, 2025, via online form distributed through the CoC newsletter, CoC Membership meeting announcements, and the CoC website.
