# CE Matching Update

### **Review of September matches:**

#### **PSH Matches**

- New Bern Crossing: 15 (currently at 29/40 matches)
- Wake CoC: 8
- Women Center: 2

# Vacancy Reporting Policy



### Recommendation

CE team to draft a vacancy tracking policy to share with CES committee for review.

#### **Purpose**

- Provide transparent access to housing interventions for all providers and participants.
- Support data accuracy and system accountability.
- Standardize vacancy reporting format and schedule.
- Designate provider point persons for vacancy updates.

### Current Challenges

- Inconsistent reporting frequency
- No current CE policy to guide how vacancies are reported in advance of each meeting.



### Vacancy Trends

### **Current vacancies**

- 8 McKinney vacancies (SPMI)
- 10 RAHP (Wake CoC PSH)
- 11 New Bern Crossing Vacancies (PSH)
  - 1BR (1)
  - 2BR (10)

### **Limited Rapid Rehousing Vacancies**

- Last family vacancies for RRH were shared mid August.
- Last single/family vacancies for RRH were shared end of July.

# Transfer Request Policy



### Transfer Policy Recommendation

#### <u>Purpose</u>

- Promote housing stability by matching clients to the most appropriate level of care.
- Ensure transfers are equitable.
- Support transparency and consistency in transfer decisions across programs.
- Reduce returns to homelessness.

#### Transfer Request data

Since February CoC received 5 transfer requests from various RRH programs.

#### Reasons for transfer requests

- Chronic homeless requirement met, families needing higher level support.
- Funding or program limitations.





## Phasing out the VI-SPDAT

### Background & Context:

- CoC staff are managing requests for training and access to the VI-SPDAT.
- VI-SPDAT is currently a tie-breaker in prioritization criteria, but not typically needed.
- **Recommendation**: Immediately phase out the VI-SPDAT to reduce requirements and minimize extensive client assessments.
  - Requires focus on chronic homelessness documentation for matching and adequate notes provided in the match/warm handoff documents.
  - CoC team has ICF TA support to finetune these steps as we prepare for replacement assessment tool and/or local prioritization questions.
