

CE Enrollment – HUD Requirements

Requirements



- 1 Actively Engaged
- 2 Enrolled in a Program

- Actively **engaged** in a project that provides services such as outreach, shelter, or supportive services to ensure **meaningful engagement** and accurate referrals.
- For example, if a client is identified during outreach, they must be **enrolled** in your agency's Outreach project **before** CE enrollment.

CE Enrollment – HUD Requirements

Requirements



- Current Living Situation (CLS) data element be completed at the time of CE enrollment, changes in CLS and updated with client interaction.
- You are responsible for entering and maintaining this information in HMIS
